Comments: (such as, notable birds seen, interesting bird or animal behavior, condition of the birding site, participant comments): It was a brisk start, however as the sun continued to rise with the temperatures, the birds became more active. The group followed the trail up to the 3rd bridge crossing the wetlands, approximately 1.25 miles out and returned for a 2.5 mile walk. 
