

2025 Christmas Bird Count

The 2025 Christmas Count was held on Saturday, December 20. The weather was cold to start out, with a low of 30, but otherwise the day was pleasant, partly sunny with a high of 53 and light winds.

We tallied 92 species, and a total of 13,485 birds, both of which are in the average range for us. Highlights of the count were a Merlin, found by Ann Steighner's group, which we have had only one other time in the last 50 years, and a Common Merganser on Lake Brandt, which we've had 5 other times in the last 50 years. We also had a surprising Green Heron, which we have had 9 times in the last 50 years. We have previously had Gray Catbird 17 times since 1974, but always only one. This year we had three.

We beat our previous record for Red-headed Woodpecker (44) by one bird, and Red-bellied Woodpecker were one bird short of our previous record (148). We had our second-largest count of Hermit Thrushes at 40 – the most we've had was 43 in 2023. We don't always get Purple Finches, and when we do it's usually single digits, but this year we had 16.

The large number of Double-crested Cormorants that have inhabited the lakes for the last 4 winters showed up again, but not quite at the 2022 high number of 1,737. Still, given that the previous high before 2022 was 729, they made a good showing.

The American Coot was once a staple of the count, found every year, but we had none this year. No Common Loon, either. We've usually had at least one Great Horned Owl on the count, but not this year. We've had Baltimore Oriole almost every year for the last ten, but none this year.

And I always have to comment on the Vultures. While the overall Vulture numbers were down a bit from our average (perhaps not the best soaring weather), the Black Vultures did **not** outnumber the Turkey Vultures, as they have done for most of the last 10 years.

The total list is below.

We had 44 counters in the field, and 3 doing Feeder Watches. Altogether they put in 128 party hours of birding, walked 58 miles and drove 190 miles. Many thanks to the birders who made this count happen:
