**Bird List:** Mourning Dove, Ruby-throated Hummingbird, Great Blue Heron, Belted Kingfisher, Red-bellied Woodpecker, Downy Woodpecker, Acadian Flycatcher, Eastern Phoebe, Yellow-throated Vireo, Blue Jay, American Crow, Carolina Chickadee, Tufted Titmouse, White-breasted Nuthatch, Carolina Wren, American Redstart, Northern Parula, Northern Cardinal; for a total of **18 species**.

**Comments: (such as, notable birds seen, interesting bird or animal behavior, condition of the birding site, participant comments):**

The weather was a little cool at the start. Several bird species were vocal in the vicinity of the Trail head. It was a beautiful walk; however, we did not hear or see a lot of birds at this location.
