Naturalist Dennis Burnette joined the group to share information about binocular use. Participants practiced their skills by focusing on pictures of a variety of bird species that would be expected in the area. Dennis also presented a mini-lesson on the variety of sparrows that might be found at Price Park during this time of the year.

After the presentation, everyone walked around the area looking for the birds discussed. Even though only 15 species were identified, the group found the target birds—the sparrows they had expected to see.

Attending the event were four youths, four parents, and five volunteers from the Piedmont Bird Club and T. Gilbert Pearson Audubon Society.
