We had an excellent weather day, and the birds were vocal and active. We saw a number of swallows flying over the lake near the Kathleen Clay Edwards family branch Library. The area near the Price Park Meadow area was also active. The Eastern Bluebirds in that area were staking out their territory and Bluebird Houses. The Tree Swallows were also staking out one of those houses as well. The area over on the Highwoods Trail was also active. All in all an excellent day and Bird Walk.
